Above: Allen Goodger's Lots 53 & 60 which produced the wonderful cock SA-82-11829, patriarch to the famous line of winners of the late John Pryor. Lot 53 was just another untried yearling at the time of the sale, a son of the famous \$1900 cock. Lot 60 was the winner of a minor race, but was about to become a famous name. In 1991, three of her sons (to two different cocks) bred the first three placegetters in a difficult race from Temora 816km. Top Left: The eye of the Cook-Winner (SAD-71-22703) taken when she was seven years old. Left: Allen in front of his first loft, built at his mother's house not far from where he raced so successfully in Hampstead Gardens. Note the exposed back at the top of the rear wall. Below Left: Brian Donovan's fine blue cock, winner of the SAHPA's race from Temora (800km) in 2003. He is a current demonstration of the continuation of the Goodger line. Below: The famous loft in Hampstead Gardens. Note the similar rear wall of the loft, ensuring plenty of ventilation and a dry interior.
